



## KEY WORDS

### HABITAT

The area in which an animal or plant lives. A habitat has sufficient food, water and shelter for an animal to survive.



### CAMOUFLAGE

Patterns and colors that blend in with the surrounding environment. Animals and insects may have camouflage markings to help them remain hidden in their surroundings.

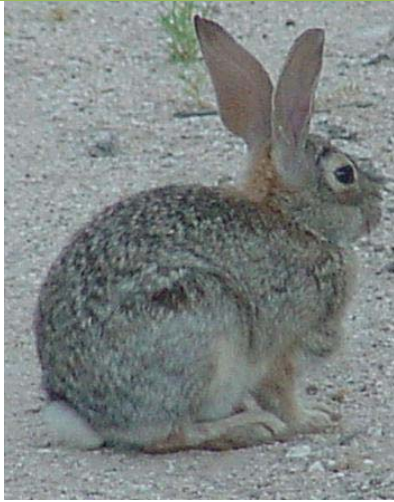
### PREDATOR

An animal that eats other animals, such as bobcat, coyote, mountain lion, roadrunner and rattlesnake.





## KEY WORDS



### PREY

An animal that is eaten by the predator is called prey such as deer, round-tailed ground squirrel, and rabbit.

### HERBIVORE

A plant eater such as a rabbit or deer.



### CARNIVORE

A meat eater such as a bobcat, roadrunner or rattlesnake.



## KEY WORDS

### OMNIVORE

**Something that eats both plants and animals such as a coyote or raccoon.**



### INSECTIVORE

**An animal that eats insects such as the regal horned lizard.**
