1. Birds by David Alderton. Small picture book with simple descriptions & explanations of bird characteristics.
2. Bird by Eyeknow Series. Excellent picture book for k-1.
3. Birds by Eyewonder Series. Beautiful photos of birds identifying ranges of diversity & behavior.
4. Bird by Eyewitness Series. Covers natural history, behavior, courtships habits, flight, food, nests etc.
5. Bird Nests & Eggs by Pinau Merlin. Identifies 54 desert nests, 43 bird eggs and brief histories of desert birds.
6. Fifty Common Birds of the Southwest by Richard Cunningham. Clear colored photos with short descriptions including behavior characteristics.
7. Secret Lives of Common Birds by Marie Read. Beautiful large colored photos with behavior traits and activities of common birds.
8. Winging It. A Beginner's Guide to Birds of the Southwest by Catherine, Cynthia, James & Vivian Coulter. Forty-two birds described by size, color, habitat, food, nest, eggs, migration, call, folklore & unique behavior.
9. Birds of the Southwest by Lynn Hassler. Beautiful colored photos & descriptions of many of our southwest birds.
10. Birds of the American Southwest by Lynn Kaufman. Photos with information on preferred habitats, markings & characteristics of each species.
11. Everything Bird (What Kids Really Want to Know About Birds) by Cherie Winner. Fun, informative beginner book for children.
12. Birds by Kevin Henkes. Fiction book for k-1.
13. How Birds Migrate by Paul Kerlinger. Why, when, where, how of migration.
