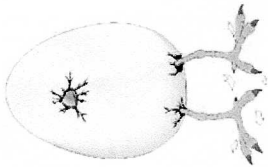


Beaks and Feet

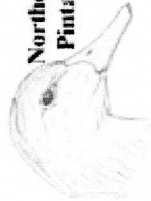
Northern Cardinal
