After Your Visit - Activity 2

Sabino Canyon Big Book

Activity Procedure

1. Have students compile all the art projects, stories, and letters from each activity of the Sabino Canyon Field Trip Supplemental Activity Units, to create a diary-like "Big Book" of Sabino Canyon. The drawings, stories, and letters will be collected in one book for the whole class to share and cherish. This will serve as documentation of the class's preparation for and field experience at Sabino Canyon.
2. Have the students explore various design ideas for collecting their projects in a Big Book. Some possible options include: an accordion-style book with the art projects, stories and letters pasted on to the fold-out pages; a collection of the projects in a big binder with a decorated cover; a 4 foot high "walk-in" book with all the written and drawn activities glued in, etc.
3. Give the students the option to expand the Big Book by conducting additional research on a desert animal or plant and how it fits into the environment of Sabino Canyon. Include extra drawings, poetry and letters that the students wish to add.
4. Put the Big Book on display in the classroom so students, visiting parents, and other classrooms can look through it and enjoy learning about Sabino Canyon.
